And Priscilla Coblentz—whom many of you will remember from our retreats in Italy—will once again bless us with the healing gift of her voice. She will also share her insights into the practice of harmonic alignment.

And together with your openness, your insight, and your questions, I believe we can form an experience that can only be God's Kingdom.


